

Warehouse Management Enhancements

Bin Putaway:

- With 2025.2, users are able to import large volumes of putaway data by importing a CSV file.
- Note that this enhancement does not require WMS.
- To import a Bin putaway CSV file in NetSuite, go to the Import Assistant page,
 - Select “Transactions” from the drop-down list on the “Import Type” Field.
 - Select “Bin Putaway Worksheet” from the drop-down list on the “Record Type” field.
- The Bin Putaway Worksheet is a manual process, and the CSV import will improve time efficiency.

Bin Blocking:

- Through the app, a user can block bins using the “Bin Empty” button within Work Order Picking.
- Blocking in WO Picking allows users to proactively identify and resolve bin related issues during Picking.
 - Prior to 2025.2, this was a WMS System Rule, Enable Bin Reporting and Blocking exists.
 - After 2025.2, Bin Blocking is extended to the Work Order.
 - WMS can now configure primary AND additional recipients on Location Record or enabled under General Preferences>Custom Preferences as to whom receives notifications on Bin Blocking.

Bulk Pick Assignment:

- Bulk Assign Pick Tasks can now be assigned by Item Process Group or by Item Process Family.
- When setting criteria on Bulk Pick Task record, all items/picks will be assigned, and they will appear as a sublist.

Auto Generation of Serial Numbers:

- With 2025.2, NetSuite can automate serial number handling to reduce manual errors in PO Receiving and WO Assembly Tasks.
- This is a WMS Rule that can be applied to Work Order Build or PO Receiving.
- This WMS rule can be selected by setting Process Type. If set to blank, it will apply to both. Then fields to be set on Item Record. Including Number Format, starting sequence, etc.
- In Mobile Configuration, you can select/add elements that are used to auto configure Serial Numbers. Fields show in Mobile when receiving PO.
